- Must possess a working knowledge of the principles, and techniques of interviewing, case management, and crisis intervention;

Job Duties:

- Provide child protection services- to children and families;
- Work with others in the community in preventative care and maintenance;
- Formulate and implement casework plans, in collaboration with others
- Investigates & evaluates reported cases of neglected, abandoned or abused children;
- Coordinates CPS investigation process related to the child and family;
- Knowledge of all standards when children are taken into care;
- Coordination of support services when children are taken into care;
- Providing voluntary placement services;
